**We've been learning about Winter and how the weather has been changing. We explored with ice and snow, we talked about how to keep warm in Winter.**

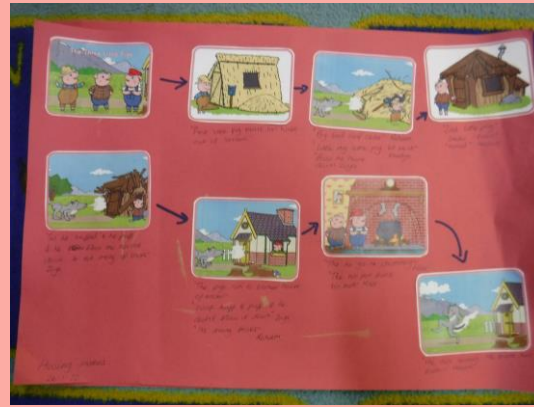
## STEM Week



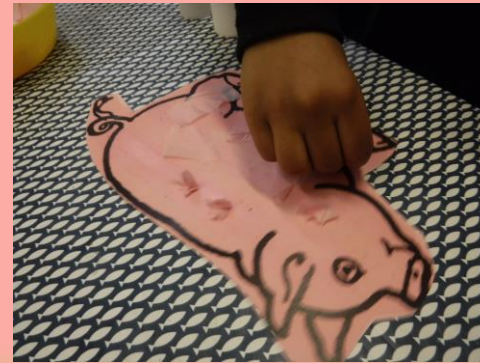
We have been learning about the different people who help us- doctors, firefighters and the police. The animal man came in to Nursery, we held and touched different animals and learnt how to care for them.

# Jack & The Beanstalk



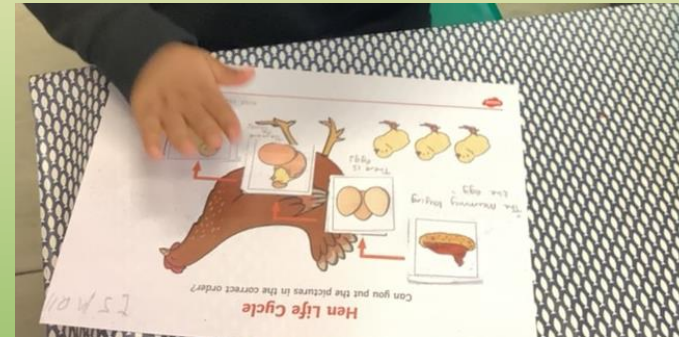
March 2022
