Class Dojo is not the appropriate platform for discussing personal issues or concerns. If you have specific concerns, please contact the teacher directly through a private message or schedule a meeting.

Negative comments about teachers, children or school policies are not allowed. If you have concerns, we encourage you to communicate privately with the teacher.
